INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT

TO THE MEMBERS OF KOLBA FARM FAB PRIVATE LIMITED.

I. Report on the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statements

1. Opinion

- A. We have audited the accompanying Standalone Financial Statements of KOLBA FARM FAB PRIVATE LIMITED ("the Company"), which comprise the Balance Sheet as at March 31, 2023, the Statement of Profit and Loss (including Other Comprehensive Income), the Statement of Changes in Equity and the Statement of Cash Flows for the year ended on that date, and a summary of the significant accounting policies and other explanatory information (hereinafter referred to as "the Standalone Financial Statements").
- B. In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the aforesaid Standalone Financial Statements give the information required by the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") in the manner so required and give a true and fair view in conformity with the Indian Accounting Standards prescribed under section 133 of the Act read with the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015, as amended, ("Ind AS") and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, of the state of affairs of the Company as at March 31, 2023, the profit and total comprehensive income, changes in equity and its cash flows for the year ended on that date

2. Basis for Opinion

We conducted our audit of the Standalone Financial Statements in accordance with the Standards on Auditing specified under section 143(10) of the Act (SAs). Our responsibilities under those Standards are further described in the Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statements section of our report. We are independent of the Company in accordance with the Code of Ethics issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI) together with the independence requirements that are relevant to our audit of the financial statements under the provisions of the Act and the Rules made thereunder, and we have fulfilled our other ethical responsibilities in accordance with these requirements and the ICAI's Code of Ethics. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion on the Standalone Financial Statements.

3. Key Audit Matters

Key audit matters are those matters that, in our professional judgment, were of most

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significance in our audit of the Standalone Financial Statements of the current period. These matters were addressed in the context of our audit of the Standalone Financial Statements as a whole, and in forming our opinion thereon, and we do not provide a separate opinion on these matters. We have determined the matters described below to be the key audit matters to be communicated in our report.

Information Other than the Standalone Financial Statements and Auditor's Report Thereon

- A. The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the preparation of the other information. The other information comprises the information included in the Management Discussion and Analysis, Board's Report including Annexures to Board's Report, Business Responsibility Report, Corporate Governance and Shareholder's Information, but does not include the Standalone Financial Statements and our auditor's report thereon. Our opinion on the standalone financial statements does not cover the other information and we do not express any form of assurance conclusion thereon
- B. In connection with our audit of the financial statements, our responsibility is to read the other information and, in doing so, consider whether the other information is materially inconsistent with the standalone Financial Statements or our knowledge obtained during the course of our audit or otherwise appears to be materially misstated. If, based on the work we have performed, we conclude that there is a material misstatement of this other information; we are required to report that fact. We have nothing to report in this regard.

5. Management's Responsibility for the Standalone Financial Statements

- A. The Company's Board of Directors is responsible for the matters stated in section 134(5) of the Act with respect to the preparation of these Standalone Financial Statements that give a true and fair view of the financial position, financial performance, total comprehensive income, changes in equity and cash flows of the Company in accordance with the Ind AS and other accounting principles generally accepted in India. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with the provisions of the Act for safeguarding the assets of the Company and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities; selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the standalone financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.
- B. In preparing the Standalone Financial Statements, management is responsible for assessing the Company's ability to continue as a going concern, disclosing, as applicable, matters related to going, concern and using the going concern basis of

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accounting unless management either intends to liquidate the Company or to cease operations, or has no realistic alternative but to do so.

The Board of Directors are responsible for overseeing the Company's financial reporting process.

6. Auditor's Responsibilities for the Audit of the Standalone Financial Statements

- A. Our objectives are to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the Standalone Financial Statements as a whole are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error, and to issue an auditor's report that includes our opinion. Reasonable assurance is a high level of assurance, but is not a guarantee that an audit conducted in accordance with SAs will always detect a material misstatement when it exists. Misstatements can arise from fraud or error and are considered material if, individually or in the aggregate, they could reasonably be expected to influence the economic decisions of users taken on the basis of these Standalone Financial Statements.

- E. We also provide those charged with governance with a statement that we have complied with relevant ethical requirements regarding independence, and to communicate with them all relationships and other matters that may reasonably be thought to bear on our independence, and where applicable, related safeguards.

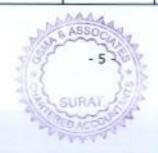

Note No. 1.0 Accounting Policies & Notes on Accounts

1. Accounting Policies:

The financial statements have been prepared and presented under the historical cost convention on accrual
basis of accounting, in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India and comply
with the mandatory Accounting Standards issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India.

2. Valuation of Inventories:

3. Revenue Recognition:

Revenue from Operations

- Sale and operating income include sale of products, income from job work services, export incentives, etc.
- Sale of goods are recognized, net of returns and trade discounts, on transfer of significant risks and rewards
 of ownership to the buyer. Sales include excise duty, sales tax and value added tax.
- Sale of services are recognized when services are rendered and related costs are incurred.
- Revenue from job work services is recognized based on the services rendered in accordance with the terms
 of contracts.
- Export benefit are accounted for in the year of exports based on eligibility and when there is no Uncertainty in receiving the same.

Other income

- Interest income is recognized on time proportion basis taking into account the amount outstanding and the rate applicable.
- Dividend income is recognized when right to receive is established.
- Rent income is booked as per terms of contracts.

4. Fixed Assets & Depreciation

- Fixed Assets are value at cost less depreciation. The depreciation has been calculated at the rates provided.
 No depreciation has been taken on the value of land.
- Cost includes all expenses of bringing the asset to its working condition for its intended use. Any trade discounts and rebates are deducted in arriving at the purchase price.
- Borrowing costs relating to acquisition of tangible assets which takes substantial period of time to get ready
 for its intended use are also included to the extent they relate to the period till such assets are ready to be
 put to use.
- Assets under installation or under construction as at the Balance Sheet date are shown as Capital Work in Progress.
- Depreciation is provided as per the Written Down Value Method, as per the rates prescribed under the Income Tax Act, 1961.

5. Borrowing Costs:

 Borrowing costs directly attributable to the acquisition, construction or production of an asset that necessarily takes a substantial period of time to get ready for its intended use or sale are capitalized as part



of the cost of the respective asset.

 All other borrowing costs are expensed in the period they occur. Borrowing costs consist of interest, exchange differences arising from foreign currency borrowings to the extent they are regarded as an adjustment to the interest cost and other costs that an entity incurs in connection with the borrowing of funds.

6. Contingent liabilities:

- A provision shall be recognized when the Assessee has a present obligation as a result of a past event, it's
 reasonably certain that an outflow of resources embodying economic benefits will be required to settle the
 obligation, and a reliable estimate can be made of the amount of the obligation.
- A contingent liability is a possible obligation that arises from past events whose existence will be confirmed
 only by the occurrence or non-occurrence of one or more uncertain future events beyond the control of
 Assessee or a present obligation that is not recognized because it's not probable that an outflow of
 resources will be required to settle the obligation.
- A contingent liability also arises in extremely rare cases where there is a liability that cannot be recognized because it cannot be measured reliably, the Assessee does not have recognized a contingent liability but discloses its existence in the financial statements wherever required.
